

New Course!

THERAPEUTIC MENTORING

Course description:

Youth mentoring has a critical role to play in supporting children and their families and in helping to bridge gaps in access to effective care. In this course, students will develop an understanding of the history, effectiveness, and competencies related to therapeutic mentoring. This will include coverage of best practices in youth mentoring, strengths-based, culturally responsive approaches, supportive accountability, building and maintaining strong relationships, and working within diverse systems of care. This course will be taught by a pioneer in therapeutic mentoring with lectures from mentoring, mental health, and community leaders.

This is a 16-hour course and students who complete the course will receive **1.6 CEUs** and a **certificate from the Center from Evidence-based Mentoring**. There will be no assignments to complete between sessions. Lectures will be held over Zoom and taught by various instructors and guest speakers, including: Josephine Cardona, MA; Kathryn Kurtz, PhD; and Jean Rhodes, PhD
